The parties agreed I was properly constituted as an arbitrator under their Collective Agreement with jurisdiction to hear and determine the matter in dispute.

This arbitration concerns a grievance brought by the Union on behalf of Gary Hjelt, the grievor (grievance #KMD0021).

After hearing evidence and submissions I assisted the parties in reaching a resolution of this matter hereinafter referred to as the Settlement Agreement.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- The grievor is required to get a medical clearance prior to returning to work
- The grievor will have his physician complete the appropriate return to work forms by January 20, 2006
- Assuming the forms are completed properly and the grievor is cleared to work, he will return to work by January 31, 2006
- The grievor will return to work without back pay
- The grievor will have to requalify for vacation entitlements
- The Employer will not incur any additional costs whatsoever, regarding the grievor's pension

• The grievor will be expected to attend work on a regular basis and in no

event will his absenteeism be greater than the average of the shop as

calculated on a quarterly basis based on the previous quarter

• The grievor shall retain his seniority upon his return to work. However,

on his return to work he will assume a vacant position and then will use

his seniority to bid into future job postings.

• This Settlement Agreement constitutes full and final settlement of all

matters arising out of grievance #KMD0021.

• This Agreement shall remain in effect from February 1, 2006 to January

31, 2008.

• I shall retain the necessary jurisdiction to resolve any dispute arising out

of the implementation of this Agreement
